THE DESIGN THINKING PROCESS INVOLUES SEVERAL KEY STAGES:


- Empathize: Understanding the needs and perspectives of others.

About ISRO


ISRO is the national space agency. It operates as the primary research of the Department of Space (DOS), which is supervised by Narendra Modi.

History of Chandrayaan 1

Chandrayaan was launched on 22nd of October 2008 by the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) from Srihari Kota, India. This satellite consisted of the orbiter and Impact probe (MIP), and Its mission was to discover the mineral composition, Including water molecules. Chandrayaan was a success in its goals and the major objective: - Discovery of Water.

After the success of Chandrayaan 1, ISRO launched Chandrayaan 2 on the 22nd of July 2019, but this time with an orbiter, a lander called Vikram, and a rover called Praygan. However, during the final stages of the mission, the lander Vikram lost contact, resulting in the failure of the mission.

Mission and Vision of Chandrayaan 3

The primary objective behind Chandrayaan 3 is to land a rover on the moon surface. To achieve this, the mission will contain GSLV carrying the Chandrayaan-3. This will be a great achievement for India and an immense amount of knowledge about space for human beings.

The Great Day

On 23rd August, the Chandrayaan 3 had landed on the moon with an applause of clapping all over India. The prime Minister, Mr. Narendra Modi, call it a Historic Day and declared August 23rd as National Space Day to commemorate the remarkable achievement of Chandrayaan-3's landing on the moon. India became the first Nation to land a spacecraft near the moon's South pole.

Beloved Parents and Cherished Students,




